Stainless Steel Water Trucks



Over the years, Ledwell has built Stainless Steel Water Tanks. Many of those tanks were for the developing world. Customers in Africa and the Middle East use several Potable Stainless Steel Water Trucks to deliver drinking water.

Recently, Ledwell reconfigured their stainless steel tanks by including baffles that meet National Fire Protection Association NFPA (1901) Standard for automotive fire apparatus. Building these tanks under this code, allows greater range of use for multiple application in the rental industry. One example, Fire Departments are able to operate this particular tank when major wild fires occur.

Vacuum Joint Review

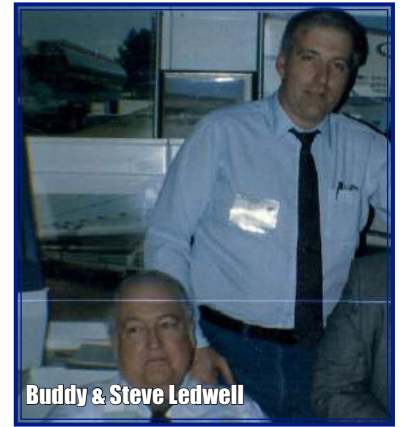
Ledwell is required to be reviewed every three years for our fabrication and repair on both Code and Non-code Vacuum equipment.

This past March we had our joint review, and we passed with flying colors. Ledwell is officially:

Recommended for our second renewal with the ASME (U Stamp for fabrication) and National Board (R Stamp for repair) by the joint review team from HSB Global inspection agency and TDLR (Texas Dept of Licensing and Regulation).

Between March 2010 and March 2016, we've built over 500 vacuum tanks: trailers or truck mounts. Most of these are code vessels.

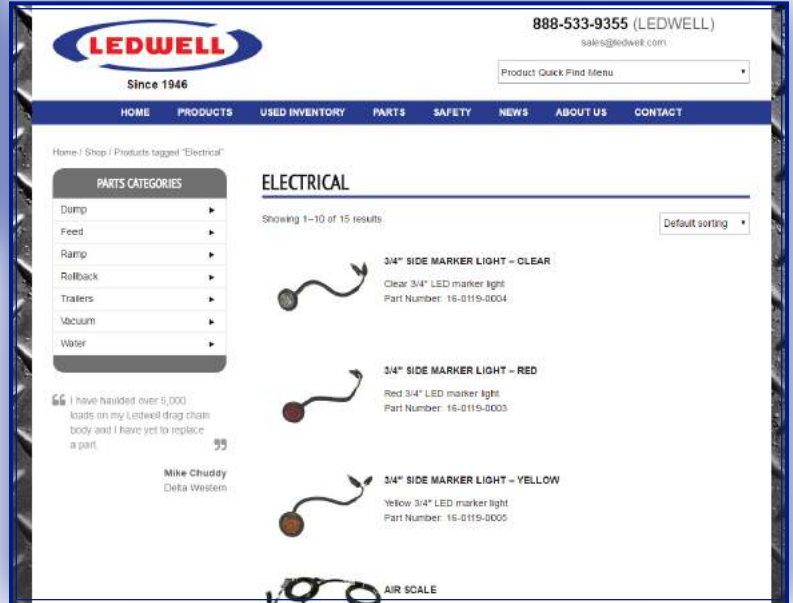
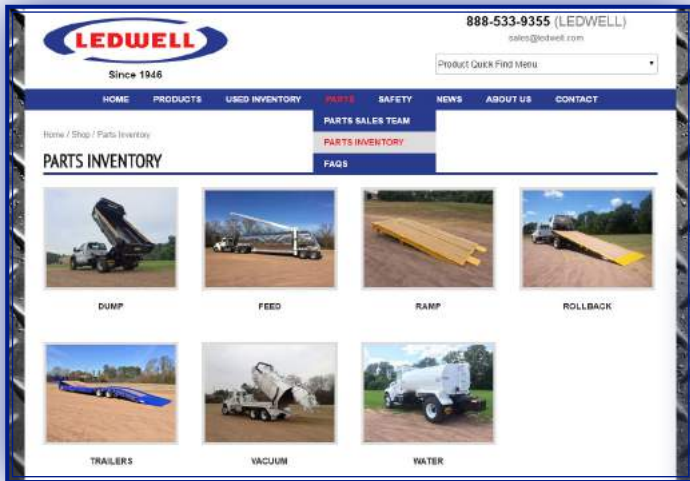

CASA focuses on helping children and their families during the darkest times in a child's life. Ledwell is proud to help support this organization and the good work they do in the community.

CASA is an acronym for Court Appointed Special Advocates for Children. Their mission is to provide hope, healing, and justice by advocating for abused and neglected children through comprehensive services. CASA of Northeast Texas is a qualified 501c3 and serves about 1,000 children in 10 counties in Texas and Arkansas.

This year marks a significant milestone for CASA for Children Texarkana - they are celebrating 25 years in the community. Over the past two and a half decades they have taken strides toward positioning its program as the leader in child advocacy. CASA imagines a future where every child has the safe and loving home they deserve.

CASA has several fundraising events throughout the year; the biggest is Songwriters on the Edge of Texas. Songwriters is a yearly concert and golf tournament put on to raise funds that go directly to support services CASA of Northeast Texas provides to local abused and neglected children. Other fundraising is done throughout the year to involve the entire community including, a 5k Color Run and Operation Playhouse, where volunteers construct different playhouses that are auctioned off to the highest bidder.
